In addition there will be a PiWi from grape to glass focused session of talks led by Professor Greg Dunn from Plumpton College Wine Division with Ben Brown from Agrii and Sergio Verillo from Blackbook Winery.

Seminar Subject Introductions:

Piwi Vines & Wines

PIWIs are an exciting collection of disease resistance grapevines that offer vineyards in the UK the ability to crop more reliably, use fewer pesticides and produce fruit more sustainably in terms of environmental impact and production efficiency within the vineyard. There is increasing demand for PIWI vines in wine regions the world over. However, there is still a lot to learn about their management in UK vineyards along with their use in winemaking. Added to this, there are some significant marketing issues that remain to be addressed.

This seminar series will begin with understanding exactly what PIWIs are and then move through managing them in vineyards and their use in the winery. This will be followed by discussion led by the panel of speakers.

Regenerative Viticulture

If you are interested in how to start exploring a move away from 'conventional' practices and adopting a more holistic and regenerative approach to vineyard management, then this seminar is not to be missed!

Wine is by its nature a very social product, providing a unique opportunity to invite conversations about provenance, terroir and cultivation. Justin will be presenting a fascinating session discussing the positive impact growers can have on climate and biodiversity.

Dr Greg Dunn

Greg is the head of the wine division at Plumpton College, the only facility in the UK that trains oenologists and viticulturists at undergraduate and postgraduate level. Greg completed his PhD in the Botany Department at the University of Melbourne in the 1990's, after which he undertook research in forest hydrology and native forest silviculture in Victoria and sub-tropical Queensland, Australia. For the last two decades Greg has acted in a range of positions in research, education and training in the Australian wine industry. Greg is currently deputy editor for the Australian Journal of Grape and Wine Research.



Ben Brown, Agrii

Ben is a viticultural agronomist at Agrii working across a number of vineyards in England with both large and small growers. He has a keen interest in terroir and maximising the potential for each specific site. With a background in horticultural and agricultural research, he takes a reasoned and practical approach towards agronomy looking at how practices in the vineyard can best influence wine quality.



Tom Archer, Rootwave

Tom is Head of Marketing for RootWave. RootWave kills weeds using electricity to give better weed control whilst protecting health and helping nature restore its soils, water and biodiversity. Tom is a crop protection specialist, he joined RootWave from UPL where he was European portfolio marketing manager, with over 20 years' experience in weed control markets and new product development.



Sergio Verrillo, Blackbook Winery

Sergio grew up in the US, a son of Italian and Hungarian immigrants surrounded by wine lovers who would vinify their own blends in the back garden and drink wine with breakfast. His wine career took off at pace when he moved to London in the noughties. He enrolled at Plumpton College in East Sussex where he earned a degree in Viticulture and Oenology in 2014. He spent the next few years as a travelling winemaker in many of the great wine producing regions with a focus on cool climate pinot noir & chardonnay.

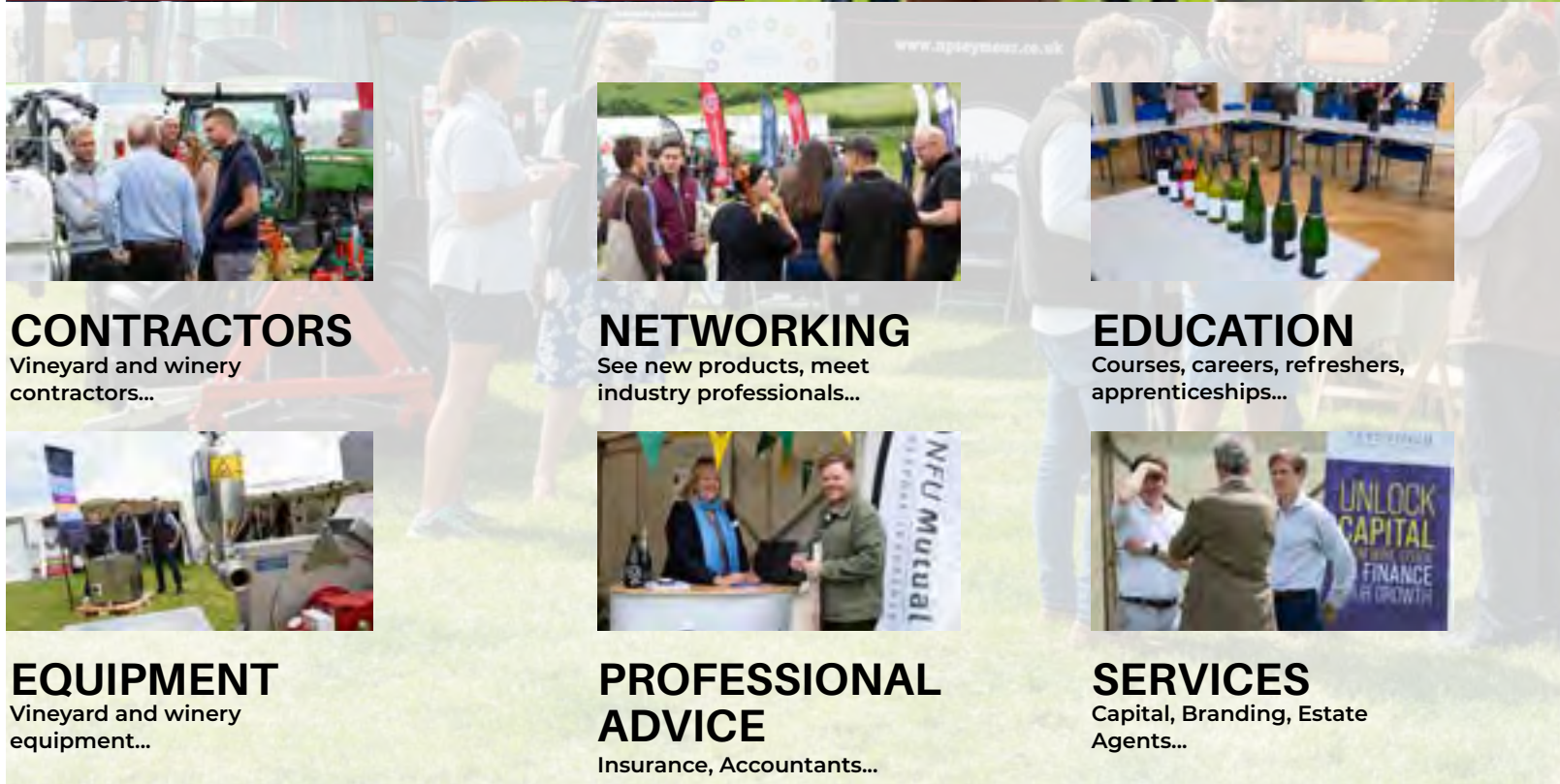

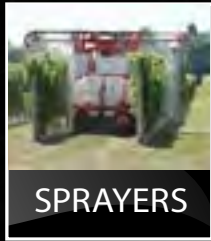

UK company launches field-scale tractor-powered electrical weed control for orchards, vineyards and fruit

RootWave, the Warwickshire based electrical weed control (eWeeding) manufacturer, has launched its first tractor-powered machine for orchards, vineyards and fruit.

In independent trials in orchards last year, the company's patented high-frequency eWeeding system delivered full control of weeds, similar to results from trials in sugar beet and maize during the same summer (2022).

The RootWave machine treats weeds in the rows of vines, bushes, and trees using treatment electrodes on purpose-designed hydraulic arms, to work seamlessly between different row widths of crops. The treatment uses electricity to create heat within the weed and roots boiling them from the inside out.

Growers can reserve a machine now, with those first in the queue able to secure delivery in spring 2024.

In 2018 the company successfully launched a professional hand-held eWeeder RootWave Pro, and has sold over 150 units in the UK and Europe.

CEO Andrew Diprose said: "RootWave delivers better weed control in fewer treatments at a lower cost. It will become the indispensable tool for farmers that want effective weed control without any environmental issues.

"Our technology is certified organic and helps nature restore its soils, water and biodiversity."

Lower energy use

In the company's own tests eWeeding provided full control of weeds at a lower total energy use than chemical herbicides.

Mr Diprose said: "RootWave delivers the most effective, economical, environmentally friendly and safe weed control on the market.

"It works so well because the plant and roots are killed by heat generated within the weed itself. And because it works so well, the number of applications you need in a season is comparable to that of herbicides and less than required for mechanical weeding. We are the only eWeeding provider using high-frequency electricity, which has significant advantages over standard 50Hz or DC wave forms."

The machine is powered by the PTO on a standard tractor. Growers will be able to see commercial prototypes working at demonstration days this summer, and can reserve a machine now for 2024 delivery direct with the company.

BLACKBOOK WINERY **Nightjar Crows Lane State** **Pinot Noir 2021**

Essex born and Battersea bred, hailing from Crows Lane Estate, situated on the coastal peninsula of Crouch Valley and positioned between the rivers Crouch & Blackwater, the vineyard is a beautiful south facing site with clay soils. The 2021 vintage has given us an aromatic, elegant style of pinot noir reflecting England's cooler climate. The wine has with structured acidity, showing beautiful delicate red fruits and black pepper spices. Fermented naturally in small open top fermenters and aged in Burgundy oak barrels. Unfined and unfiltered. May contain sediment.



CARR TAYLOR WINES **Ortega 2022**

This is a dry, lightly oaked wine with subtle white peach and elderflower flavours, with a hint of vanilla.

Our on-site winery is kitted out with a 2 tonne pneumatic Willmes press, Seitz filtration unit and approximately 25 fermentation and storage tanks. We also have bottling and labelling machinery so that all aspects of wine production through to dressing the finished product are carried out on site.



HEPPINGTON **Chardonnay 2021**

Matured in French oak barrels, this Chardonnay from the 2021 vintage has notes of fresh white peach and lightly toasted spice with a palate of ripe stone fruit and a bright citrus finish.

Wine GB awards 2022 - Silver Medal



PLUMPTON ESTATE **Brut Reserve 2017, English** **Quality Sparkling Wine**

Plumpton Estate Brut Reserve is a powerful blend of Reising, Seyval Blanc, Pinot Blanc and Regner. The base wine is fermented in tank, then again once in bottle. This wine has been aged for five years on lees to infuse pronounced tertiary aromas. The unique blend of several varieties produces a one-of-a-kind, alternative wine to traditional method champagne varietal wines.

Clear, defined aromas of yellow plum and pears give centre stage to a powerful nose of brioche and tarte aux amandes. Rich mouthfeel that evolves from toast into citrus. Pair with fish and poultry as well as tartes and cheeseboards.



SUPPORTED BY THE CHEESE SOCIETY

My name is Kate O'Meara and I have a background in both hospitality and retail and created The Cheese Society in 1997 at the beginning of the internet era. Originally we sold difficult to obtain, farmhouse, mainly unpasteurised cheese purely by mail order to individuals and trade customers from our warehouse in Lincoln. As the business expanded, I bought the property in St Martins Lane in Lincoln in 2001, opened the cheese shop and added a 'cheese cafe', which at the time was the first in the UK, consisting of an entirely cheese-based menu.



STANLAKE PARK WINE ESTATE Orange 2022

This wine was made with very mature Siegerrebe grapes, with one week of skin contact, and was fermented in used oak barrels for 8-10 days. By soaking with the skins, the grape juice acquires extra fruit and tropical aromas, an oily, mouth-filling texture and a very persistent finish. The wine is not 'orange' in colour as we've chosen to avoid oxidation in order to retain the fresh and delicate fruit aromas.

Aromas of wild flowers, cantaloupe melon, quince and ripe pear; dry, with a very good texture balanced by a crisp body and a long finish.



WHITE CASTLE VINEYARD Regent 2021

Harvest 2021 of our Regent grape variety delivered a wonderful fruity aromas and dark cherry flavours, producing a delicate, deep coloured quality red wine.

The grapes were hand harvested in October 2021 and the juice fermented in stainless Steel vats, a further ageing in Oak barrels has enhanced the subtle flavour.

Over the years, I have judged at many cheese awards and shows both in Britain and abroad, which has presented me with the opportunity to seek out new cheeses and meet a huge array of different cheesemakers.

My daughter, Lucie joined the business in 2016, becoming part of our trained team of knowledgeable cheesemongers, and bringing with her a strong design background and an inherited love of cheese! She has worked on improving our website and has made buying cheese online so much easier and approachable.

The Cheese Society shop and cafe is still housed in the same building to this day and has evolved over time, becoming a firm favourite and popular destination for locals and cheese lovers from far and wide. Cheese is our passion and we aim to obtain the best products possible to share with our customers both online and in the shop.

LINDUM

Lindum is a washed rind, cow's milk cheese from the Cote Hill Dairy in Lincolnshire. Regular washing in the 'Bomber County Beer' gives the cheese its natural pink rind, which develops a pungency as it is allowed to mature.



DAZEL ASH

This delightful goat's cheese from the New Forest has an edible ash coating which matures into a crinkly rind which takes on a lustrous satiny, dark hue of black and white.



COTE HILL BLUE

A superb unpasteurised blue cheese made in Lincolnshire, similar in style to a soft textured blue brie, creamy with a definite sharpness and rich, complex flavours. The cheese is incased in a thin grey rind.



SHEEP RUSTLER

Sheep Rustler is a semi-hard, Ewe's milk cheese from Shton Mallet. The cheese has a distinctive orange/brown rind with the occasional bright spot of natural mould. The flavour is warm and nutty with a lingering hint of sweetness. Perfect for summer with notes of fresh grass and meadows.



SWALEDALE

A fresh, crumbly Dales cheese with sharp flavours but buttery undertones. Swaledale Traditional is based on an ancient recipe developed hundreds of years ago and has similar characteristics to a farmhouse Wensleydale, a brilliant alternative, but with softer and creamier notes and more delicate less astringent flavours.



BARON BIGOD

Baron Bigod is an exquisite Suffolk made, bloomy pasteurised cows milk cheese in the style of a classic brie-de-meaux. A full-flavoured soft cheese with a nutty, mushroomy rind. The smooth, silky golden paste that will often ooze out over a delicate, fresh and citrusy centre. You will find long-lasting flavours of warm earth, farmyard and mushrooms, with occasional notes of citrus and truffle.

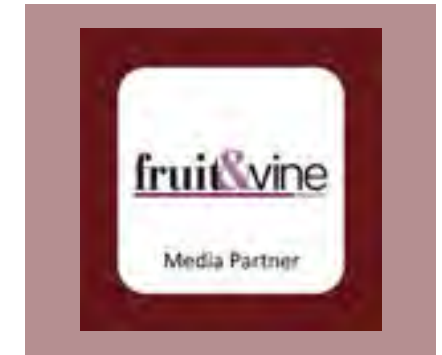
